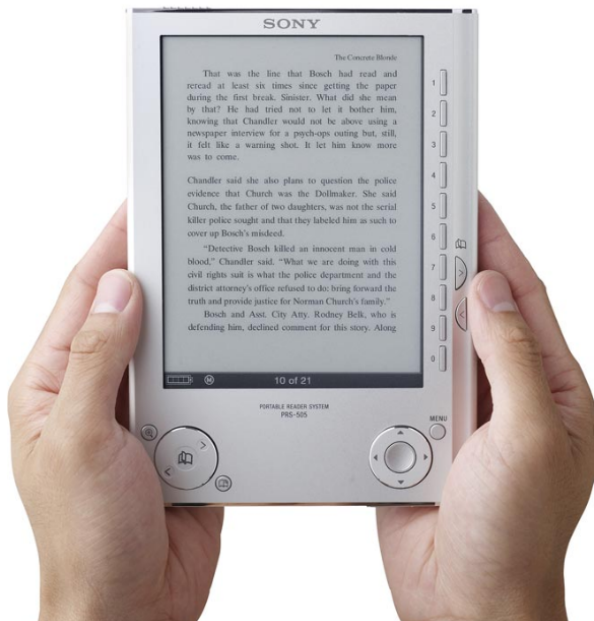

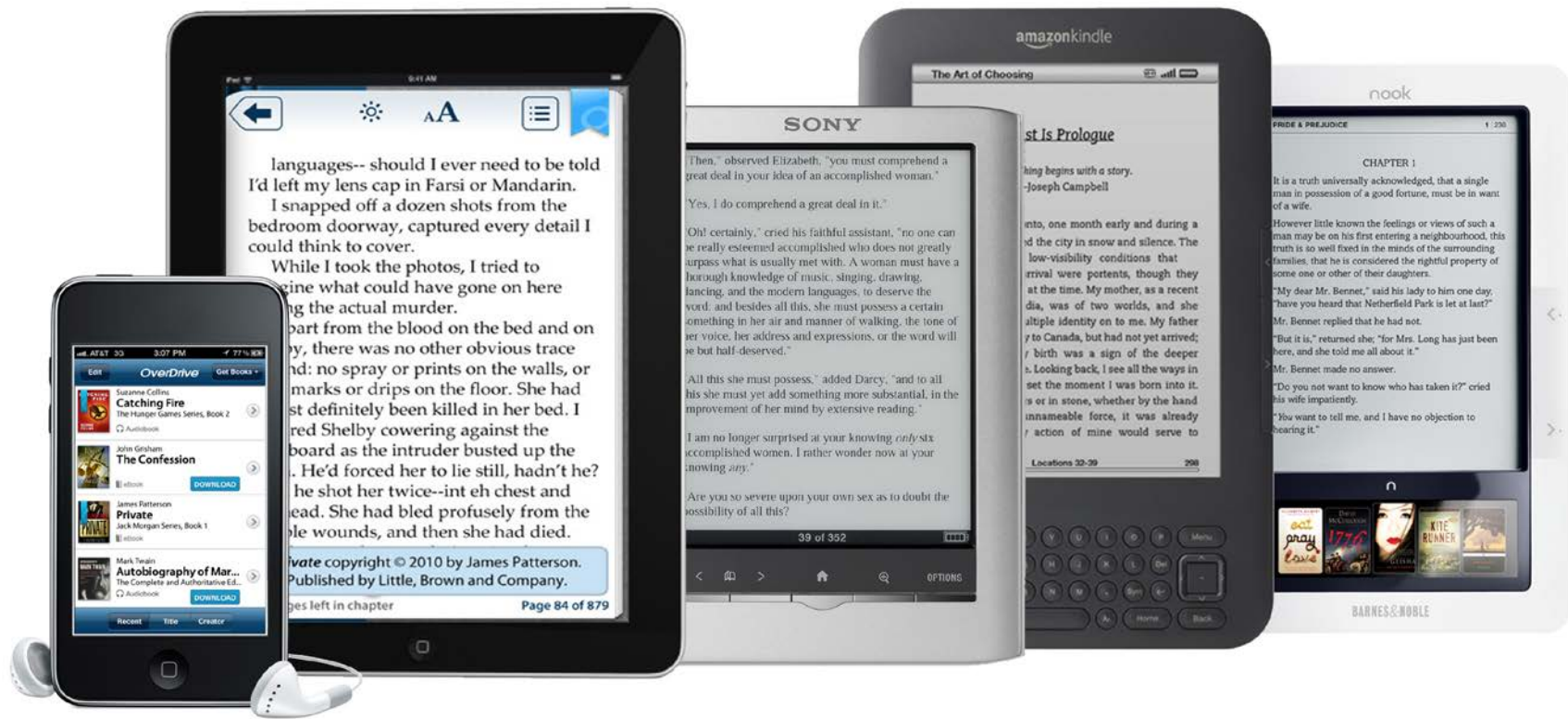

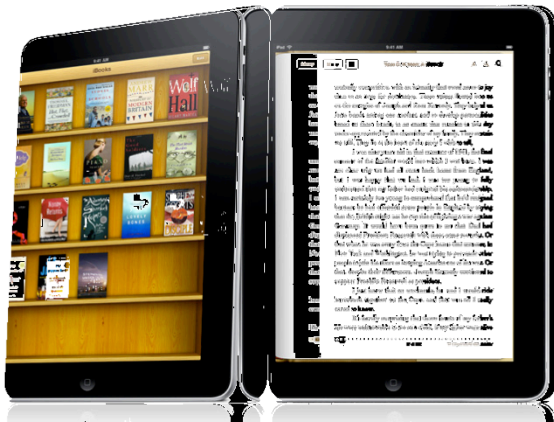

➤ EPUB3

➤ Latest approved specification in Oct 2011

- Supported by many eReaders
 - Except Kindle

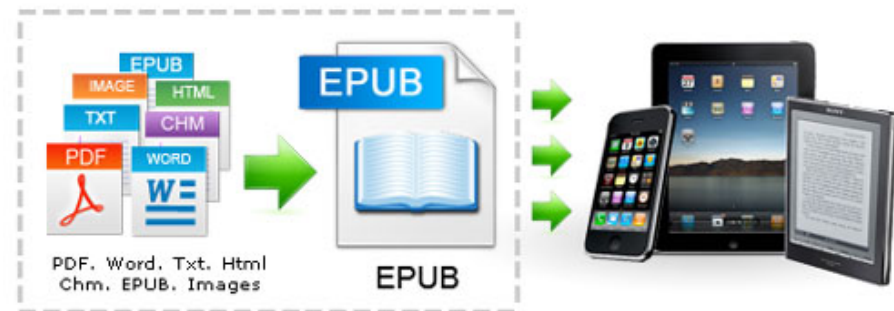
➤ Applications that are used to generate ePub files

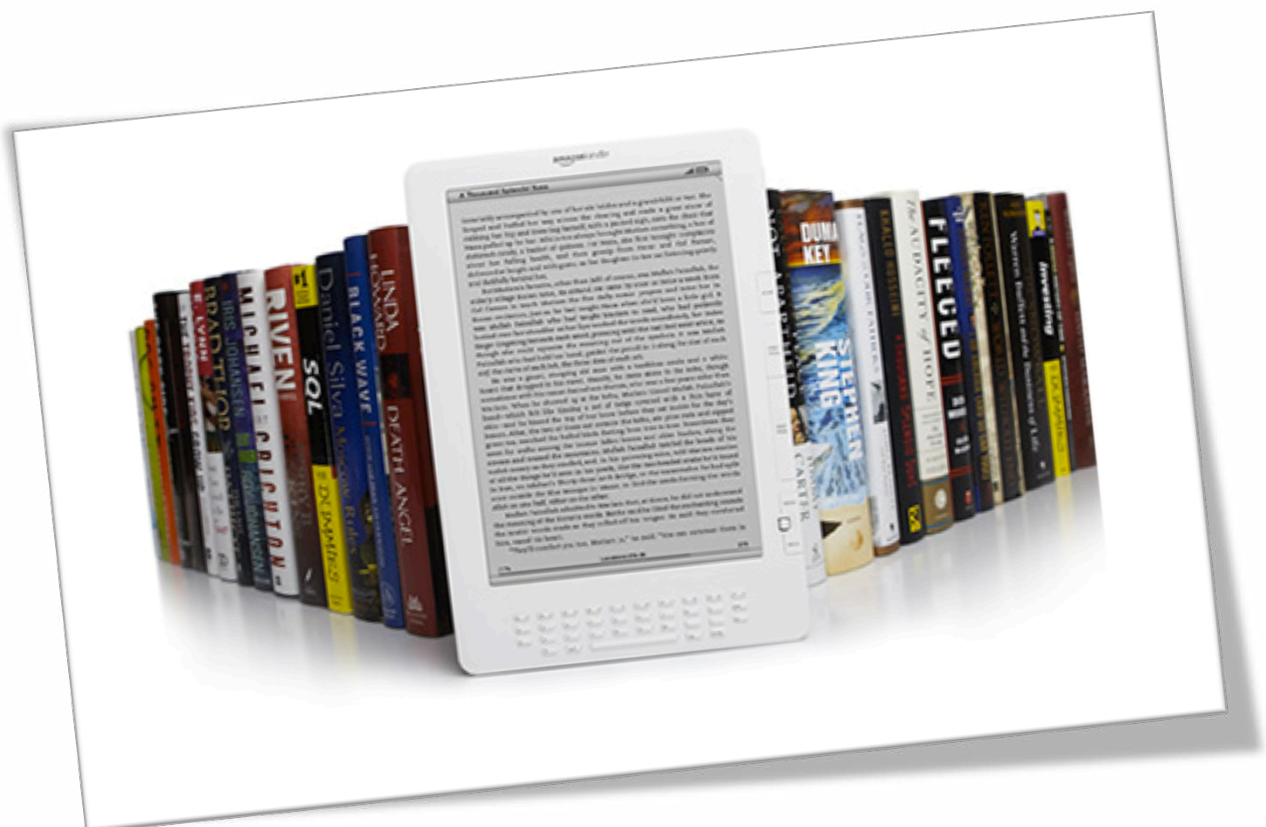
